



### Flowering Times

If you choose carefully you can have peonies in flower for eight weeks. Flowering times will be affected both by temperature and where you live. A walled garden in Kent can be as much a three weeks ahead of peonies in our exposed field in Lincolnshire. This table shows how some of our peonies have performed on average over time.
